Acting Village Mayor Matt LeBier called the meeting to Order at 5:00 PM and led the attendees in the <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> . The Town Supervisor introduced Town Board Members.

Mr. LeBier presented Joint Recreation Commission’s request for 2021/2022 Budget versus Village Proposed Budget for Joint Recreation Commission. He noted that there are no grant funds available presently for the Zamboni, and hope to work with NYPA for some type of funding for an electric Zamboni. They will proceed with purchasing the Zamboni either way, as the old one needs replacing. Mr. LeBier proposed eliminating municipally-funded concession and possibly cutting one position to part time. The proposed funding levels show a savings of \$31,913 for the Village and \$20,492 for the Town over the Department’s Request.

Joint Recreation Director Mike McCabe noted they would advertise for interest in running the concession for the winter. Supervisor O’Shaughnessy suggested food trucks may be interested, eliminating workers compensation and overhead issues.

There was also discussion about eliminating the parking and Pavillion rental fees at the Beach, hoping that this would increase use of the beach, and possibly increase concession revenue (and maybe hire another lifeguard or concession worker).
