

The Massena Public Library Board met on April 11, 2023.

The trustees received 4 applications for the part-time library assistant for the children's library; 2 candidates will be interviewed April 12 and 14 and the trustees then hope to make their decision. The recently hired library clerk is in training and will be taking the Civil Service exam. The replacement for the full-time adult services library assistant is also training 1-2 hours per day. The trustees are also continuing to search for a new library director. The application deadline was extended to April 15th and then interviews will begin; the plan is to have someone in place 2-3 weeks prior to Elaine retiring. Elaine is preparing a list of her daily/weekly/monthly duties.

A number of events will be held during National Library Week (April 24-29) and National Library Giving Day on April 25; please refer to the library's web page and/or newsletter for details.

In addition to sponsoring several events, the Friends of the Library is progressing with their process to become a 501c3; they hope to have it completed by the end of June.
