

UPDATES FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2023 MUSEUM BOARD MEETING

August activity: 5 accessions, no deaccessions. 93 visitors (increased activity due to Mega Reunion).

Historian is working on a display for the Not-for-Profit fair at the library on Sept 28th. Josh is also working on a display for the St. Lawrence County Historical Association's "History in the Hallway" exhibit during October at the County Office Building. The Museum brochure has been completed and is being printed. Josh has worked on 6 general research projects and is also working on grant writing.

The Archivist shared numerous pictures from the Mega Reunion.

- * the grant for the addition was due for a final completion report on Sept 9; the town filed for and received a one year extension, citing supply chain issues.
